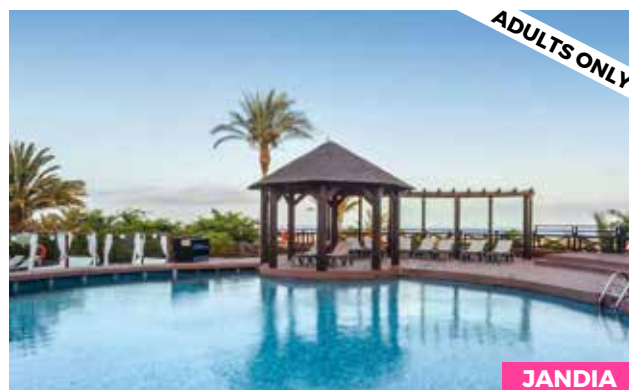

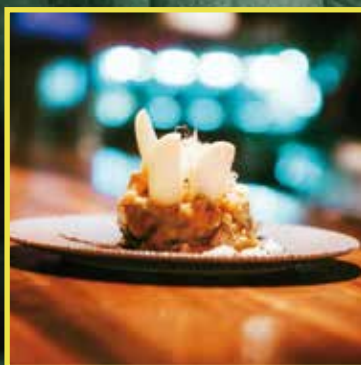

# Your How-To for buying a property in Spain

**Buying a house in Spain opens up many opportunities, whether you would like to move to the country, buy a property as an investment to rent out, or use the real estate to obtain nationality. However, the purchasing process can seem daunting.**

**Here is our Step by Step guide to buying a property in Spain.**

Any foreigner can buy a house in Spain. The first (and most important) thing you will need is an NIE number, the identification number assigned to foreigners in Spain to carry out any type of legal procedure. Second, it's essential to open a bank account in Spain since all taxes and expenses associated with the sale, must be paid through it.

Once you have found your property, the purchasing process usually takes another 2-3 months, although it can take longer if you decide to apply for a mortgage.

The process of buying a house in Spain involves three essential stages.

## **1. The procedures before the sale**

Once the seller has given you a copy of the Notarial Deed of the property that contains the information relating to the Property Registry (for example, it specifies who is the owner of the property), Carpe Mundi can go to the registry and request a simple note, a document confirming the

property is free of debts and charges (such as mortgages).

## 2. Reservation Contract

The reservation contract corresponds to the moment the buyer deposits 1 to 5% of the property price, depending on what is agreed.

## 3. Purchase and sale contract with Arras clause

In most cases, when buying and selling a property in Spain, a sales contract is signed with a clause called Penitential Deposits.

Typically, the buyer provides an initial payment of 10% of the total purchase price. Once paid, the seller is obligated to sell the property to you. If they don't, they will have to refund you double the amount you paid (20% of the total price). However, if you, as a buyer, do not complete the purchase, you will lose that 10%.

## 4. Mortgage search

It is advisable, even before you start looking for properties, to study the buyer's solvency so that, once you have chosen the property you want to buy, there are no surprises because you are unable to get the finance required for the property. The granting of finance is linked to the appraisal of the house.

## 5. The signing of the Public Deed before a Notary.

The purchase and sale of properties are formalised with the signature of a Notary. This appointment brings together the buyer and the seller. The Carpe Mundi Inmobiliaria professional will be with you throughout the process. The mortgage will also be signed (if required) at this time. This is when the transfer of the property is made and the keys will be handed over to the buyer.

## 6. Property Registry Registration

Carpe Mundi Inmobiliaria must register the property with the Property Register to identify the new owner and then forms referring to the payment of property transfer taxes must be completed. The period to make said payment is 30 days from the public deed.

Finally the transfer of ownership for public services must be made. For example - gas, water and electricity.

Be thorough in your planning to avoid any setbacks along the way.

# Blue Flag

**The Blue Flag award is an annual honour and certification for environmental quality, created by the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE) in Spain. It's managed by the Association for Environmental and Consumer Education (ADEAC).**

This recognition is given to beaches and marinas that excel in water quality, adhere to environmental laws, and provide the necessary health and safety facilities to ensure the well-being and safety of visitors.

Fuerteventura is home to numerous stunning beaches, and it's comforting to know that many also meet the high standards for water quality, public safety, and environmental preservation. Announcements are made every May about which beaches have been awarded or have retained the Blue Flag. In 2023, an impressive 11 beaches in Fuerteventura were honoured with a Blue Flag.

## 1 - Playa Butihondo

A semi-urban stretch with a low occupancy rate, is situated north of Morro Jable, nestled between Barranco de Esquinzo and the Butihondo valley. Spanning just over 1.5 kilometers in length and with an average width of 45 meters, its fine golden sand and crystal-clear waters make it an ideal spot for relaxation and a break from the daily grind.

### Good to know

Surveillance and rescue tower, adapted bathrooms, access walkways with ramps, beach bar, amphibious chairs, shaded areas and hammock service.

## 2 - Playa Los Pozos

Finding a well-maintained beach with quality services and a pleasant atmosphere in an urban area is a delightful surprise. The white-sanded Playa Los Pozos, also known as Playa Chica, offers visitors a chance to enjoy the beach right in the capital of Fuerteventura. It's situated in the southern part, adjacent to the Paseo Marítimo.

### Good to know

Showers, toilets and changing rooms, as well as restaurants and shops just 10 meters from the beach. Parking next to the beach in one of the adjacent streets.

### 3 - Playa La Concha

Playa La Concha, found in El Cotillo, stands out as one of the most family-friendly beaches in the north of Fuerteventura. Spanning 200 meters in length and 50 meters in width, it features white sand and gentle waves. This stunning beach with clear water is a perfect spot to spend the whole day and enjoy its breathtaking sunsets.

#### Good to know

Ample parking, toilets and showers, watchtowers, wooden walkways adapted for wheelchairs and strollers, cleaning, and trash cans.

### 4 - Gran Tarajal

Gran Tarajal's beach, in the town centre, stretches 800 meters in length and approximately 55 meters in width. It is characterised by its black sand and calm waters, despite being somewhat windy at times. The beach is bordered by Punta del Camellito on one side and the seaport breakwater on the right.

#### Good to know

Access for the disabled, a playground on the beach sand, showers, toilets, parking nearby.

### 5 - Las Grandes Playas

Las Grandes Playas has a length of almost 3.5 kilometers and an average width of 60 meters. A large part of these spectacular beaches are located within the Corralejo Dunes Natural Park. The thick white sand and the soft and moderate waves make the large beaches of Corralejo one of the favourite places to spend time with children.

#### Good to know

Plenty of free parking space, bus stop, and supermarket, certain areas have sun loungers, and surveillance and rescue towers.

### 6 - Playa Costa Calma

An extensive bay from the tip of Los Molinillos to the Risco del Gato urbanization. In the middle is a beach of 2,190 meters long and an average width of 40 meters, which in some sections reaches up to 300 meters. This beach of fine white sand is windy, but the sea remains calm. It has crystal-clear waters that make it attractive for diving or windsurfing. It has numerous services, such as rental of umbrellas, hammocks, and even boats. It has a playground and a sports area.

#### Good to know

Costa Calma has 2 surveillance and rescue towers, 2 adapted bathrooms, an access walkway with ramp, 2 beach bars, adapted showers and footbaths, amphibious chairs, shaded areas and hammock service.



### 7 - Puerto Lajas

It is the first time that Puerto Lajas has been awarded a Blue Flag. The beach is located in the urban area of Puerto Lajas, a small village near Puerto de Rosario, with gray/black sand and measures 700 meters long and 31 meters wide. The waves are moderate and even though it can be quite windy, it's a pleasant and not very busy beach to spend the day.

#### Good to know

Puerto Lajas has 2 surveillance and rescue towers, showers, bins and a children's area. The beach is cleaned regularly and there are a few restaurants and bars.

### 8 - Playa de El Matorral

One of the most extensive beaches in Morro. Here you will find a 12-kilometer stretch of white sand and because of its strategic location, you will be able to catch glimpses of spectacular sunsets. Due to its vegetation capable of withstanding the salt water floods that usually arise during high tides, it is also considered a protected natural space. Being so extensive, there are areas that are very different from each other. Towards the north there is a more tourist area, with hotels and recreational areas, and in other parts of the beach, you will find quieter and more secluded areas.

#### Good to know

El Matorral has 5 surveillance and rescue towers, 4 adapted bathrooms, 4 access walkways with ramps, 4 beach bars, adapted showers and footbaths, amphibious chairs, shaded areas and hammock service.



### 9 - Playa Morro Jable

This beach is characterised by its turquoise and emerald waters, as well as an avenue with shopping centers that borders the beach. It also has food outlets so you can taste the typical dishes of the area. The golden sand stretches four kilometers and has areas to rent hammocks and umbrellas so you can fully enjoy this earthly paradise.

#### Good to know

Morro Jable has a surveillance and rescue tower, an adapted bathroom, an access walkway with a ramp, a beach bar, adapted showers and footbaths, amphibious chairs, shaded areas and hammock service.

### 10 - Playa Corralejo Viejo

Located in the center of Corralejo, in the north of Fuerteventura, and praised by experts for its accessibility and safety. One of the most impressive aspects of Corralejo Viejo is the crystalline color of its waters, in addition to the calm sea, which allows visitors to swim in complete tranquility. It has a length of 195 meters and a width of 25 meters.

#### Good to know

Due to its location in the center, the beach is easily accessible. There is a public toilet and several bars and restaurants nearby.

### 11 - Playa Blanca

A quiet semi-urban beach, only two kilometers from Puerto del Rosario, that measures 875 meters long and more than 40 meters wide where you can enjoy its golden sand. Due to quite strong waves it is ideal for practicing sports such as kitesurfing, surfing or windsurfing, but be very careful when swimming.

#### Good to know

Playa Blanca has ample parking at various points near the beach, as well as a playground, showers and toilets.





# Dunes of Corralejo

**The Corralejo Dunes, a safeguarded region in the northern part of Fuerteventura, span over 2,600 hectares, making them the most extensive dune area in the Canary Islands.**

This remarkable landscape was designated a Natural Park in 1994, harmoniously integrating human conveniences with natural beauty. Situated in the town of Corralejo, this area stands out as a prime attraction on the island.

This area is recognised as part of the Canary Islands' Natural Spaces, alongside the island of Lobos. Both locations are identified for their ecological significance by the European Economic Community, emphasising the importance of minimising ecological impact. Additionally, the dunes and Lobos Island are designated as Special Protection Areas for birds (SPA).

## **Origin**

The dunes' distinct rounded hills of sand originate from the breakdown of mollusk shells and other marine organisms, creating layers of fine white sand through

the accumulation of millions of shells brought in by sea currents to Fuerteventura's northeast coast. Contrary to popular belief that the dunes consist of Sahara-blown sand, it is estimated that Sahara dust contributes merely between 20 and 80 grams per square meter annually to the Canary Islands.

## **Flora and Fauna**

The dunes are a sanctuary for unique plant life, not through water but through species exclusive to Fuerteventura. Given the low annual rainfall, plants here thrive on the salt-laden humidity from the nearby sea and enjoy prolonged sunlight hours compared to other islands.

The flora includes jable star onion, jonquils, honeydew, sea buckthorn, and star chives, some of which are rare finds elsewhere. The fauna features a variety of birds, both from the sea and land, such as the Maxorata, sandgrouses, sandpipers, kestrels, and pipits. Visitors between January and May should tread lightly to avoid disturbing the nesting birds during this sensitive period.
